Two projects this architect can be proud of...

This month Vande Hey Raleigh is featuring two beautiful homes in the Madison, Wisconsin area that were designed by Bouril Architects. These homes are unique in many ways; and the Vande Hey Raleigh Roof Tile is no exception.

The owners of the first home, located on the outskirts of Madison in the Village of Fitchburg, requested many custom samples to be made before finalizing on the final color and texture. Because of the exterior colors, the surrounding landscape and the sheer scope of the house, led the homeowners to choose a three color blend rather than two, including: Light Charcoal Gray, Graphite Gray and Cocoa Brown. All of these colors were distributed evenly across the roof at 33% each. In addition, while most homes receive only one tile texture, this home received two different textures. A "fine rake" on the Light Charcoal and Graphite Gray colors and a "brushed" texture on the Cocoa Brown. Finally, the Cocoa Brown color received a black antique spray to give the overall roof an authentic feel.



The second house featured here was built on the shores of Lake Mendota in Madison, Wisconsin. Because this house is located directly on the water, the homeowners felt that a hint of blue/green would be a nice touch to help their home blend into their lake front surroundings. This unique roof displays a custom sequence of Sea Green and Brown Colonial. The profile chosen for this roof is Old Flat with a "shake" texture with 50% of the tiles misted Charcoal Gray. Lastly the solid green tiles were sprayed Brown Colonial at 50%.
